EARTHQUAKE COMFORT KIT UPDATE INSTRUCTIONS WHEN YOUR CHILD HAS AN EXISTING KIT AT THE SCHOOL

This notice is for parents/guardians who have already provided an Earthquake Comfort Kit for their child. Please note a new or updated kit *does not* need to be provided each year.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEDICATIONS

If you wish to provide us with any medications (i.e., ventolin inhaler, epipen, seizure medication, etc.), please bring the medication, labeled with your child's name, to your child's classroom by **Friday, October 30, 2015**. Check expiry dates and provide an adequate supply. Please be aware that any medication you have already provided to the school classroom or office may not be available in the event of an earthquake. Medication is returned every June with an opportunity to replace it every September.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPDATING EMERGENCY CONTACT CARDS – PLEASE OBTAIN FROM SCHOOL OFFICE

The Emergency Contact Card is critical as it will serve as your child's identification. It is inserted in a plastic sleeve to be worn around your child's neck and, like the Earthquake Comfort Kits, they are stored in an outside bin. The bin is accessed only in September and June.

It is your responsibility, as your child's parent/guardian, to ensure you provide an Emergency Contact Card and that the information is correct.

If you wish to change any information on the Emergency Contact Card, please obtain one from the school office, ensure it is filled out completely and accurately, and return it to the school office by **Friday, October 30, 2015**.
